Digestivo (2 oz)

Distilleria Montanaro, Barolo Chinato, Italy 18

An aromatized wine made from Dr Montanaro's original recipe. Its origins date back to the end of the 19th century. The chemists of Langhe area applied the much valued properties of Cinchona to the Barolo wine creating a drink which originated as having medical properties, however over time has become one of the most sophisticated proposals of Albese enology. The balance among Barolo, the king of wines, the China Calissaia, the rhubarb, the cinnamon, the cloves, the Gentian and some other spices make a unique and lovely aromatized wine.

A real contender in the ring! Bold spiced plums & blackberry jam. Coffee cream, licorice and vanilla.

2014 Shiraz blend, John Duval, 'Plexus', Barossa Valley, South Australia 150

John Duval was personally mentored by Penfold's own Max Schubert and was chief winemaker at Penfolds for many vintages before starting his own label. Expect an intensely layered, full bodied wine rich with ripe, dark fruit, and exotic spice. Truly a benchmark wine from an esteemed producer.

2008 Grenache blend, Noon Winery, 'Eclipse', SA, Australia 200

Complex and rich blend from the much celebrated Noon Winery. Full and well fruited.

2014 Shiraz, Samantha's Garden, Two Hands Winery, McLaren Vale, Australia 220

Plush, velvety tannins and layers of perfumed fruit, finishing long and lively.

Easy to love this wine. Light, dry with a gorgeous bouquet and subtle leathery notes.

Intense honey and botrytis spice. A gentle lift from lemon zest sets this apart.

2002 Vin de Paille, La Vignière, Henri Maire, Jura 375 ml 110

Vin de Paille is the French for 'straw wine', made only in the ripest vintages. The grapes have been allowed to dry on straw mats to concentrate sugar levels as well as the intensity of flavours in the finished wine. The wine is aged in small barrels for at least three years to further develop its flavours of candied fruit, prunes, honey, caramel, or candied oranges.

2002 Riesling, Gunderloch, TBA, Nackenheimer Rothenberg, Rheinhessen, Germany-375 ml 990

A bold, assertive dessert wine. Plenty of mineral, spice, orange peel and dried apricot aromas and flavors pulse through the unctuous texture courtesy of the racy acidity. Still a little young, this needs time to integrate. Terrific finish.

Taylor Fladgate, 10-Year- old Tawny Port 90

Rich and elegant nose combining aromas of ripe berry fruit with a delicate nuttiness and subtle mellow notes of chocolate, butterscotch and fine oak wood. Smooth and silky on the palate and full of ripe figgy, jammy flavours which persist on the long finish. One of the world's most versatile dessert wines.

Taylor Fladgate, 20-Year- old Tawny Port 120

Opulent and voluptuous nose of complex spicy, jammy and nutty aromas, hints of orange flower and a fine oakiness coming from the long period of aging in cask. The palate is full of very rich and concentrated flavour and has a long mellow finish.
