The name "La Mission" dates back to the time of the crusades, when knights passing through the region of Pomerol on their way toward the Mediterranean would stop to pray in front of the Mission cross, which is still present today on the property. Expect a pretty bouquet of strawberries, raspberries, crushed stone, and flowers. The palate is velvety, lush and pure.

2018 Jacques Boyd, Margaux 168

**S** Château Boyd Cantenac is a Troisième Cru Classé of the Margaux appellation. Its vineyard covers an area of some ten hectares of siliceous gravel and is planted with vines over 40 years old: mainly Cabernet Sauvignon but also Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Expect generous ripe black and red fruit supported by dense forest floor and spice cupboard aromas. The palate is rich, full, and earthy.

Outstanding St.-Emilion. Concentrated notes of crème de cassis, black cherry, licorice, as well as a hint of truffle.

### Canada

2017 Cave Spring Select Late Harvest Riesling, VQA Lincoln Lakeshore 375ml 70  
Highly aromatic peach, and Bartlett pear mingle with exotic citrus, spice, marmalade, and comb honey.

2018 Inniskillin, Vidal Icewine, Niagara Peninsula, Ontario 200 ml 69  
Iconic Icewine literally put Ontario wines on the world stage.  
Generous with honey, dried apricot, tropical pineapple and mango. Amazing with our cheeses.

### France

2015 Castelnau-de Suduiraut, Sauternes, France 90  
Look for orange marmalade, almond, and mixed citrus sorbet. The palate is generous with ripe peach, apricot, and candied ginger.

2002 Vin de Paille, La Vignière, Henri Maire, Jura 375 ml 110  
Vin de Paille is the French for 'straw wine', made only in the ripest vintages. The grapes have been allowed to dry on straw mats to concentrate sugar levels as well as the intensity of flavours in the finished wine. The wine is aged in small barrels for at least three years to further develop its flavours of candied fruit, prunes, honey, caramel, or candied oranges.

### Germany

2002 Riesling, Gunderloch, TBA, Nackenheimer Rothenberg, Rheinhessen, Germany-375 ml 1040  
A bold, assertive dessert wine. Plenty of mineral, spice, orange peel and dried apricot aromas and flavors pulse through the unctuous texture courtesy of the racy acidity. Still a little young, this needs time to integrate. Terrific finish.

### Fortified

#### Port

Taylor Fladgate, 10-Year- old Tawny Port 95  
Rich and elegant nose combining aromas of ripe berry fruit with a delicate nuttiness and subtle mellow notes of chocolate, butterscotch and fine oak wood. Smooth and silky on the palate and full of ripe figgy, jammy flavours which persist on the long finish. One of the world's most versatile dessert wines.

Taylor Fladgate, 20-Year- old Tawny Port 107  
Opulent and voluptuous nose of complex spicy, jammy and nutty aromas, hints of orange flower and a fine oakiness coming from the long period of aging in cask. The palate is full of very rich and concentrated flavour and has a long mellow finish.
