Ruinart is the oldest established Champagne house, exclusively producing champagne since 1729.

The rosé is packed with bright pomegranate and fresh raspberry. The palate is luxuriously creamy and bright. A blend of 30–40 crus including 20–30% reserve wine kept from a range of vintages.

**Tarlant Cuvée Louis** 460

Fantastically crafted with no detail overlooked. Equal proportions of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay were sourced from 2004 and 2005 vintages. The base wines were vinified with natural yeasts and fermented in neutral Burgundian Oak. The wines were matured 16 years of on fine lees and disgorged June 6, 2022. It is full, packed with citrus, peach, and apricot flavours mingling with a beautiful, generous creamy texture.

○ Cru Bourgeois is a special classification of Bordeaux wines created in the region's famous Left Bank communes highlighting producers who create wines of excellent quality and consistency. The Roquegrave is a classically styled Cabernet blend, lean, fresh, and firm.

**2023 Maison Ginestet, Margaux** 124

Generously aromatic blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot is remarkably aromatic. Classic notes of dark fruit, baking spice, and pencil lead. Built for the cellar but drinking well now with time in a decanter and generous swirling in your glass.

**2021 Château Pontet-Canet, Pauillac** 419

○ B Château Pontet-Canet, a celebrated Fifth Growth from Pauillac's legendary 1855 Classification, crafts wines of remarkable elegance and depth, earning a reputation as one of Bordeaux's most iconic estates. Blackberries, flowers, cigar box, herbs, espresso, and spearmint nuances pop from the glass. The palate is vibrant, fresh with blackberries, chocolate, black currants, orange citrus, espresso, and spice.

**2010 Château Rauzan-Ségla, Margaux** 725

Rauzan-Ségla is often considered the best of Margaux's Second Growths. A huge nose of blackcurrants, smoked earth, tobacco, lead pencil, and spice give way to a concentrated, blockbuster styled Margaux that has thrilling depth of fruit, masses of ripe tannins, and great length and finesse on the finish.

#### Bordeaux – Right Bank

**2023 Domaine Jean-Yves Millaire, 'Loupiot', Fronsac, Bordeaux** 83

**B** Translated "loupiot" means little wolf however, the French use the term affectionately as "little child". In the glass this translates as a fresh and fun Merlot & Cabernet Franc blend ripe with red and black fruit.

**2018 Château Peymouton, Grand Cru, Saint-Émilion** 118

Château Peymouton is part of the estate of Château Laroque, a historic Grand Cru Classé of Saint-Émilion located just 3.5 km east of the medieval village. The vineyard itself was planted in the 18th century. Primarily Merlot balanced by both Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, the wine is supple on the palate showing blackberry, plum with hints of earthy tobacco and herbs from bottle age.

**2019 Château La Mission, Lalande de Pomerol** 121

The name "La Mission" dates back to the time of the crusades, when knights passing through the region of Pomerol on their way toward the Mediterranean would stop to pray in front of the Mission cross, which is still present today on the property. Expect a pretty bouquet of strawberries, raspberries, crushed stone, and flowers. The palate is velvety, lush and pure.

**2016 Château Corbin, Saint-Émilion, Grand Cru Classé** 220

Château Corbin is one of the oldest estates in Saint-Émilion. The foundations of the Château date back to the 15th century when (according to legend) the site was the centre of a stronghold that belonged to the Black Prince, an exceptional English military leader who launched successful campaigns into France. Concentrated notes of crème de cassis, black cherry, licorice, as well as a hint of truffle.

**2021 Château Clinet, Pomerol** 369

**S** 2021 Pomerol wines are a return to classic Bordeaux expressing more red-fruit side of the style range with strong aromatic profiles. offers depth of color before you get to the tobacco leaves, espresso, truffle, mint, cedar, flowers, black cherries, incense, and chocolatey plums. Plush, supple, and with ample fruit showing sweet, and tart characteristics. The wine provides lift, energy, polish, length, and an edgy finish.
